

St John Supporter Scheme

What is the St John Supporter Scheme?

As a local resident by becoming a member of our Supporter Scheme, you'll help us provide essential services and at the same time support St John. In return, you'll receive:

- free assessment and medical treatment by paramedics or other qualified ambulance staff;
- transfer by emergency ambulance, in the event of an injury, serious illness, maternity or other medical condition;
- transfer by ambulance under the direct instructions of a Health Care Professional where you are unfit to travel by any other means for treatment or medical appointment.

(Where you do not meet the conditions you will be subject to normal charges for ambulance transfers regardless of your membership to the St John Supporter Scheme.)

How does the Supporter Scheme work?

To become a St John Supporter, you pay a 2015 membership fee – either as an individual or a family. The usual part-charge for an emergency ambulance response is **over 10 times more** than the annual cost of being a St John Supporter, so our scheme offers you great value for money.



Why become a St John Supporter?

St John is a charity. We rely on your support and donations to deliver our services to you when you need us. The 2015 membership you pay to be a St John Supporter helps:

- to provide Guernsey's ambulance service, which operates 24/7 and assists thousands of people every year;
- to maintain St John rescue and community services in the Bailiwick of Guernsey;
- to develop more St John community services on the Island

Why do I need to pay for an ambulance?

There is normally a part-charge from St John for an emergency ambulance response or a non-emergency patient transfer. The part-charge arises because unlike the other emergency services, we are not fully funded by the States of Guernsey. The Grant we receive from the States of Guernsey only covers between 60% to 70% of the 'road' ambulance service costs.

The provision of the marine ambulance and rescue teams are funded from donations and bequests to St John, or the proceeds from the hire or sale of mobility equipment in our St John Health Care Shop. The grant from the States of Guernsey cannot be used to fund these additional services.

FACT

Our ambulance service is only part funded by the States of Guernsey, so we need to raise additional funds to support it and to provide our other St John community and rescue services in the Bailiwick



FACT

The donations you give us will be used in the Bailiwick of Guernsey to provide inshore rescue boats, a marine ambulance, a cliff rescue team and community first responders.

The St John community rescue services respond to over 100 call-outs a year

The ambulance service responds to an average of 12 emergencies and a further 30 patient transfers every single day

What does it cost?

SINGLE membership of £28.50 provides cover for a single person only.

CHILD membership of £10.50

provides cover for one child up until the end of full-time education.

FAMILY membership of £67.00

provides cover for a couple or single parent with children until they leave full time education.

SENIOR CITIZEN who is 65 years or over may pay a specially reduced membership of **£20.50** (for a couple both senior citizens, £41.00).

How long does membership last?

Membership is valid until 31.12.2015.

Are there any restrictions?

There is no limit to the number of ambulance responses you may have, and no age limit to become a St John Supporter; however you cannot request an ambulance just because you are a member. The fact that you may need to go for medical treatment to a hospital or other centre does not necessarily mean that you require an ambulance. Except for emergencies we only respond when a Health Care Professional decides that your transfer is necessary for medical treatment and that your condition, makes you unfit to travel by any other means.

What if I don't join?

An ambulance responding to an emergency call can incur a charge of up to £281 for each response. A non-emergency transfer by ambulance booked in advance by a Health Care Professional will incur a charge of up to £98; other charges will be applied for specialist services (e.g. paramedic treatment). As a St John Supporter you will not be charged, regardless of the number of

emergency responses, treatment or transfers you may need.

The Direct Debit Guarantee




- The Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instruction to pay Direct Debits.

 you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources
 Department to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources Department or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The States of Guernsey Treasury and Resources Department asks you to.
